Family business covers the world — of autos

The name Silver Star World Wide Auto Repair doesn't immediately call to mind the picture of a small, family-owned business. But the Ormond Beach-based shop is exactly that.

their rate for labor of \$89.70 per hour isn't as high as the \$150 per hour charged by most dealers.

The emphasis is always on quality and he says they always recommend original equipment manufacturers' parts.

"We try to do the best we can, to offer a good value and do good work with good parts," Mr. Sickich said.

The good service extends to how they care for the customer. "We offer free valet service," he said, explaining that means they give customers a ride home or to some other location so the customer doesn't have to wait around while they work on the car. "It can be home or to a restaurant, the library. We have some people who go to walk the bridge while the car is in the shop," he said.

As well as running a quality-focused business, he enjoys getting to know his customers and neighbors. He wants them to feel they can absolutely rely on getting the best service and quality at Silver Star World Wide Auto Repair.

He's also very proud the


